

**MINUTES OF THE MARCH 05, 2026 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. 800 AND DISCOVERY BAY RECLAMATION AND DRAINAGE
MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**

A meeting of the board of Trustees of Reclamation District 800 and Discovery Bay Reclamation and drainage Maintenance District was convened both in person, and via Zoom, at 1540 Discovery Bay Blvd, Suite A, Discovery Bay, California.

District Engineer Christopher Neudeck reports KSN has been working to formalize fees and the scope of work for the dredging project. Reclamation District 800 has signed contract with Catalyst to do environmental permitting. District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues and District Engineer Christopher Neudeck are working with the property owner on obtaining a lease for the parcels needed for the placement of the dredging material. A meeting will be scheduled with District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues and District Engineer Christopher Neudeck and the property owner to discuss the lease. District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues will be contacting a Real Estate firm for further information regarding obtaining the lease for the parcels. The estimated start date for the dredging project is June 2027. The District should have a good idea by January 2027 if all permits will be completed and the project can go to bid.

The maintenance crew mowed 10 miles of the levee.

The maintenance crew fixed and replaced the station markers along the levee.

There was some minor erosion from the rain, nothing major to report. The seepage at station 250+00 continues at the same flow rate.
