

**MINUTES OF THE JUNE 04, 2026 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF RECLAMATION
DISTRICT NO. 800 AND DISCOVERY BAY RECLAMATION AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE
DISTRICT**

A meeting of the board of Trustees of Reclamation District 800 and Discovery Bay Reclamation and drainage Maintenance District was convened both in person, and via Zoom, at 1540 Discovery Bay Blvd, Suite A, Discovery Bay, California.

1.Public Meeting 10:00 a.m.:

Agenda item 1.

1. *Call public business meeting to order 10:00 a.m.*

Trustee Lyman called the public meeting to order at 10 a.m. Present at the meeting was Trustee Harris Trustee Morgan, and Trustee Judge, and Trustee Bubniak. Also, present District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues, District Secretary Ashley Fritze, and District Engineer Christopher Neudeck. Alexis Fischer from Eutrophix attended the meeting via Zoom. District Attorney Scott Shapiro was not in attendance.

- 4.2 *Report and request direction on Willow Lake (Eutrophix):*

Dr. Alexis Fischer from Eutrophix presented the board with the results on Willow Lake since the three algae treatments have been applied. The numbers are in good range at this time, and the treatment is working as intended. There will be additional results at the July meeting and phase 2 algaecide program will be presented for funding.

- 4.3 *Report and request direction on dredging project:*

District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues updated the board that the dredging project is moving smoothly. Catalyst was attempting to get the District approved for an earlier work window. E.D.N.A. tested the delta water and determined the water quality is good and an earlier starting date is not possible. Placement sites for the dredging material are waiting for property appraisal.

Once appraisals are completed the District will work on negotiations with the property owner and District Attorney Scott Shapiro.

4.4 Report and request direction on South side solar project:

District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues reports the solar project was progressing some at the last meeting. The contractor hired a new project manager. After the previous project manager made an error the new project manager determined the job needs to be changed. KSN redesigned the footing for the project to help recoup the cost for the error made by the original project manager. There has been no update from the contractor as of 06/04/2026. An update will be provided at the next board meeting in July.

4.5 Report and request direction on possible DWR Emergency Material Transfer Facility at RD 800 yard:

District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues reported there is no reportable action at this time. The project will likely not be moving forward.

8.1 Financial Report:

District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues reports District funds have been transferred from the County to the District's BAC Account. PGE bill was higher this month due to turning all the siphons on throughout the bays. Everything else is within the budget at this time.

Pulte Construction contacted the District regarding a tree swing near Indian Slough; the tree swing is causing issues and liability concerns for the District and Pulte Construction. District Manager Sonnet Rodrigues is recommending the removal of the tree and swing due to the danger and liability and would like to have Tree West do the removal.

There was a motion made by Trustee Bubniak, second by Trustee Morgan to remove the tree and swing to avoid liabilities and to have Tree West do the removal.

The motion was passed 4-0.

The maintenance crew placed rock on the levee due to sloughing and removed weeds and vegetation out of the pipes to keep the water flowing. The maintenance crew reported that the trash rack is pulling away from the platform.
